- Encourage your child to support other athletes of the programme
- Encourage your child to support other squads
- Encourage your child to attend ALL practice sessions and help them understand their role
 and therefore impact of attendance in all the squads they are involved in as part of the
 programme.
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding good performances of all
- Never force your child to take part in the sport
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes
- Discourage arguing with coaches, committee members or judges
- Publicly accept judges' decisions
- Support your child's involvement and help them enjoy their sport
- Use correct and proper language at all times
- Encourage and guide performers to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour.
